These workshops will allow Oromo youth to gain personal empowerment in perusing further education, enter and maintain a position in the labor market and raise the level of understanding of how the law affects them.

The workshops will focus on three key areas as follows:

Continuing Education – This session will give general guidance on the education and training needed to enter various occupations. It will discuss practical topics to help the youth with a great deal of information about academic plans for high school and beyond, career interests, and likely readiness for college

Employment and Training – job search methods; job networks and employers; applying for a job such as resume writing, applications letters; job interview; etc.

Legal Needs – Police powers & ticket inspectors, workers rights and obligation, privacy, confidentiality and raise issues in the media.
